

Confession

Christ, there are times when you beg us to come with you, to places of haven and refuge, to be away, simple present with you, yet we resist. We would rather fill our lives with sights and sounds than to be in a place where growth is slow and quiet. We lament not following you into the garden.

**Christ, in your mercy, hear our prayer.**

Jesus, like with Peter, James, and John, you bid us to stay present and awake as we remain and abide with you. The exhaustion of life overwhelms us and when we slow down, we become tired. All too often our weariness gives way to fatigue causing our eyes to become heavy with sleep.
